Her great-grandfather, Charles Kosciuszko, was the direct descendant of Józef Tomasz Kosciuszko (1743-1789), the older brother of the Polish patriot Tadeusz Kosciuszko. She's been the French Minister for Ecology, Sustainable Development, Transport and Housing for 2 years	
4. Born in 1951 in Paris. He is a French singer-songwriter. His mother, Ruth Ambrunn, born in Germany and his father, Alter Mojze Goldman, born in Poland were Resistance heroes.	
5. She was born in 1968 in Paris Her grandparents were Polish Jewish immigrants. Her family used to speak Polish at home. She won 2 César Awards for Best Actress.

They then migrated to France after the First World War. His surname Kopaszewski was shortened to Kopa when he was at school. In 1958, he was awarded the Ballon d'Or.
